- 1. Talk Often** 💬
Narrate your day and describe what you're doing to expose your toddler to a wide range of vocabulary.
- 2. Use Simple Words** 🐾
Keep sentences short and clear to match your toddler's level of understanding.
- 3. Read Together** 📖
Share books daily and point to pictures while naming objects to build language skills.
- 4. Sing Songs** 🎵
Songs and rhymes enhance language development and improve memory for words.
- 5. Imitate Sounds** 🗣️
Repeat the sounds your toddler makes to encourage them to vocalize more.
- 6. Ask Open-Ended Questions** ❓
Use questions like, "What do you see?" to encourage your toddler to respond with words.
- 7. Expand on Their Words** 🌱
If they say, "Car," you can say, "Yes, a big red car is driving fast!"
- 8. Use Gestures** 🖐️
Combine gestures with words to help toddlers connect meaning to spoken language.
- 9. Encourage Peer Interaction** 🤝
Playdates or group activities can motivate toddlers to use language to communicate.
- 10. Be Patient and Wait** ⌚
Give your toddler time to process and respond when communicating.
